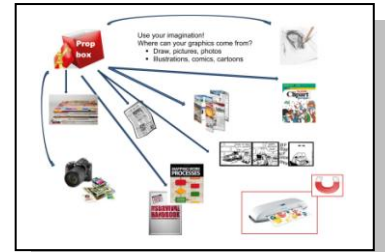


STORY BOARDING in TRAINING
